

I don't know about you but, I was really moved and blessed in our first Praise Celebration Service. The freedom and simplicity of praising God in psalms, hymns and spiritual songs, as we expressed the joy of the Lord with one another, was really spiritually refreshing. Sharing the Lord's Supper together as a corporate expression of praise was a perfect conclusion to such a time of worship. I can hardly wait for the next one on August 31st. This time we will have a church- wide covered dish lunch immediately following the service. Thank you to all who led us in musical praise. God used you to bless the rest of us and I know you were blessed as you ministered to us.

Easter is almost here and it is time for our Easter Musical Presentation, "He Is Risen Indeed", presented by our music ministry. We will also have the annual Easter doughnut fellowship and family picture taking (9:00 to 10:15 AM) followed by Easter Worship Service (with musical) at 10:30 AM. Please be praying for God's blessing on this special day and be inviting your unchurched or out-of-church friends and neighbors to come with you Easter Sunday. God can and will use the activities of this special day to touch and reach the unchurched and unsaved if we will believe God enough to work and pray to reach outside our church family to the people we are around in the course of our daily lives. That, my brothers and sisters, is a big **IF**, that rests on us. We are never to just sit around waiting for God to do something <u>for</u> us. We are to be busy and engaged in reaching out to those in our community while we trust Him to do His work <u>through</u> us.

Paul says that it is mocking God to think we will not reap what we sow. That also means that we mock God when we think we will reap anything without sowing anything. Actually it is the same thing. We reap nothing when we plant nothing. That **IS** reaping exactly what we have planted. So, let's sow the seeds of prayer and of reaching out to the unsaved and the unchurched with all that is in us, and we will reap in due season if we keep sowing and faint (quit) not.

I have one last word to say in this article. If you haven't picked up your copy of <u>The Story</u> yet, please do so. It is God's story in His own words (the Bible). <u>The Story</u> is not designed to replace your Bible or become your Bible but, to enhance your study and reading of your Bible as you see God's redemptive plan from the creation to the New Heaven and New Earth. I just finished Chapter 22, "The Birth of the King". The story of Jesus begins before creation (John 1:1-14) then moves to the announcement to Mary (Matthew) and through the events of His birth up to Jesus debating the scholars in the temple at age twelve. <u>The Story</u> simply stacks the scriptures in the order in which the events took place in the words of the Bible. The book, chapter and verse references have been removed so it reads like a novel. The plot is the

story of God's work in creation, the fall, redemption, the second coming and the New Heaven and Earth in chronological order. Not only will it enhance your understanding of the Bible but, it will be a great outreach tool to the lost and unchurched. Many are deeply interested in the Bible but are convinced that it is too complicated for them to understand. When offered a simple way to understand and grasp the Bible's message, many jump at the chance to do so. So, we can deepen our knowledge of God's Word and reach out to the lost at the same time. I can't wait!
